LAHS - COMMONWEALTH UNIVERSITY FULL-TIME EARLY COLLEGE PROGRAM 2024-2025

COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

- Must take 4 courses per semester: Math, Science, English or Social Studies must be scheduled if needed to meet graduation requirements. 1 college course = 1 credit at LAHS
- Students may also take up to 2 courses during the winter term. If a student takes a course during winter term, then the student would only be required to take 3 courses in the spring semester.
- If a student has earned a credit for a course during their middle school or high school years (i.e., Spanish I, Statistics, American History), they may not take an introductory level college course.
- All course selections for each semester will require final approval by the student's school counselor and administration *before students are scheduled into them*.
- See attached sheet for an example of courses that LAHS students have taken at Commonwealth.

RECOMMENDED REQUIREMENTS

- GPA of 90% and/or minimum PSAT score of 1090 and/or minimum SAT scores of 1100
- Proficiency on Keystone Exams
- Students should not have any attendance concerns
- Students must be self-motivated with good time-management skills, a history of meeting course deadlines, and an ability to self-advocate

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Physical Education will be completed as an Independent Study
- Meet all other graduation requirements
- Participate in Commencement ceremony in June
- Provide LAHS with Bloomsburg email address so that LAHS can provide student with important information.
 Information will also be sent to LAHS email.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Submit application online (<u>www.commonwealthu.edu/earlycollege</u>)
- Print Authorization to Participate form (on Early College website), sign and submit to school counselor
- Complete Early College Agreement, and submit to school counselor (must be submitted before courses can be scheduled)
- Meet with Early College representative at HS to schedule courses (May)

COSTS

- Tuition is discounted by 75%: \$345 per 3 credit course; \$1380 per semester (tuition is subject to change)
- Books/materials are responsibility of the student/family
- Transportation is the responsibility of the student/family

GRADES & GPA

- Grades earned in college courses will be included in the student's GPA.
- Grades will be weighted as an AP course, unless the student earns a D or lower.
- The courses and grades earned will be listed on the student's official LAHS transcript.
